## SUBJET: PROCEDURES ON THE ISSUANCE OF AN EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE

- 1. Purpose
- 1.1. The purpose of this Circular is to inform all parties concerned regarding the procedures for the issuance of an Exemption Certificate from this Administration.

## 2. Application

2.1. This Circular applies to all vessels flying the flag of Comoros

## 3. Procedures

- 3.1 An official request using the form "APPEXE" shall be made by the Recognized Organization to this Administration when applying for the issuance of an Exemption Certificate according to an International Convention/Code.
- 3.2 The request shall be accompanied by a copy of the relevant Certificate and its supplement (if applicable) and a current Survey Status Report
- 3.3 Upon receipt of the above documents, this Administration will review the request and may issue a Certificate exempting the vessel from the provisions of an International Convention/Code, if the conditions which are established by the relevant Convention/Code are complied with.
- 3.4 The validity of the issued Exemption Certificate (Maximum one year) will be harmonized with the expiration date of the relevant statutory Certificate remaining valid.
- 3.5 In case that the request for the issuance of an Exemption Certificate is not granted, the Recognized Organization will automatically be informed regarding the reasons of this rejection.
